Sir,

Our association earnestly thanks for bringing out the much coveted Order which shuttled from the L& LR and RR & R Department to the Directorate for quite a few months. The unprecedented efficiency but could not do away the malady of travesty of justice and favouritism.

We learnt that 31/12/2015 was fixed as a yard stick, for officers who have to be transferred particularly serving in DLLRO & SDLLRO offices in their districts of the Hugly, Howrah, South 24 Parganas and North 24 Parganas i.e. C-zone. About more than 70 officers came under the anvil but only half of them were chosen to be departed. Moreover, several SRO-IIs serving in the B-zone and A-zone districts, who are eligible for transfer to their home district/zone have been willfully left out or not posted to their home zone/districts for reasons best known to authorities.

We would not have had nothing to say if a zone wise 'first come first go' policy had been adopted by both the Directorate and the Secretariat for such transfers. The entire order only imprints the whims without rhyme or reason, to pick and choose the officers. It had not even spared the senior officers or the officers who are enlisted in the zone of consideration list for the promotion to the rank of SRO-I or the officers convalescing from very very serious decease which are well known to the authorities.

Once, Sri Anish Majumder, IAS(Retd.) and Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal in one of our deputation quipped that indispensability of favouring government employee by the authority against a transfer order, is a theory of band-wagon. In a revenue department such favours will always remain with askance.

Any civilized nation follows the rule of queue in any waiting line leaving apart the cases deserving compassion. We are compelled to say that the combined effort of the Directorate and Secretariat still remains far away from such etiquette.

To an extent this deleterious order has shaken the faith of the senior SRO-IIs who had fallen victim of such wangle.

Our earnest request is to partially review the order where such anomalies have occurred and reinforce the justification in cases of such infirmities. We are ready to cooperate, if required by the authority, to restore the justification and transparency of the order.
