Sub: Deprivation of SRO-IIs getting promotion to WBCS (Ex) Cadre as a feeder in the residual vacancy of 2019 to 2022.

Ref: No III/41-1SC/1P-53/2003 dated 27/2/2025 of the Public Service Commission, West Bengal.

Respected Sir,

We have come to know that during the meeting under reference, the view of the Hon'ble representative of the P&AR Department is in contrary to the prevailing rules denying the legitimate right of the eligible SRO-IIs with retrospective effect.

This is to recall here that earlier vide our correspondence No. 27 dated 30/10/2024, we have raised the issue of quota curtailment to the post of WBCS(Exe) cadre from the feeder post/service against the quota of 2023 before the authority. The matter is still in a stalemate condition.

It is needless to mention here that after formation of WBLR service in the L&LR and RR&R Department, no order has ever been passed to extirpate the right of SRO-IIs with retrospective effect.

Sir, the deprivation of the promotional right not only speaks against the career prospects of the eligible and willing SRO-II s but also against the career prospects of Revenue Officers, consequently. We have no clue behind such motive.

Thus, through your good office, our association, earnestly urges to take immediate steps to move away the stalemate situation in order to prevail natural justice.
