Sub: Transfer of Revenue Officers, particularly from the A-zone districts.

Respected Sir,

We anxiously express our concern for the Revenue Officers who are posted in North Bengal and Purulia (i.e. A-zone) for more than three years, as they deserve to be transferred to their home district or near to their home as per the well laid transfer policy guideline of the Department for the cadres.

Recently it has come to our knowledge that that your good office is now concerned with the transfer of the Revenue Officers. But we are surprised to know that the criteria for transfer from A-Zone is being considered as five-years-service in A-Zone which is not as per the transfer policy guideline. If five- years-service in A-zone is made the criteria for transfer from A-zone, then a good number of Revenue Officers will be deprived who are serving A-zone for even more than four years.

We hope that the matter can be dealt with more efficiently as per the transfer policy guidelines. Any such deviation from the existing transfer guideline or any further extension of the duration of service period in North Bengal and Purulia (i.e. in A zone) in considering the eligibility of the Revenue Officers for transfer to home district or near to their home only denies the justice in the ISU set up.

Hence, through this letter, on behalf of our association, I do pray to seek your kind attention and do the needful at the earliest. We also do pray for your valuable time to discuss the issue before you at the earliest.
