Therefore, if spouse wants to get the benefits under the West Bengal Health Scheme, 2008 an official certificate from his/ her employer is to be obtained first regarding relinquishment of medical allowance and medical benefits available from his/ her employer. Above procedures may also be followed in the case of a Government Pensioner enrolled under the West Bengal Health Scheme, 2008, in other words, if spouse is a pensioner or Government employee, both will not be entitled to get medical relief or medical allowance, as the case may be, where pensioner opts to come under the Scheme.
