Kolkata, the 2nd May, 2007.

The Governor is pleased hereby to make the following amendment in the Bengal Records Manual, 1943 as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the said Rules) namely:—

Amendment

For rule 320K in Chapter VIII of the said Rules, *substitute* the following:—

“320K. In case, any Government Department and subordinate offices thereof, Development Authority, Government Undertaking, Government Company and local body applies for collection of bulk computerized text-data like record-of-rights or any plot related information through any CD for official use or for the purpose of land acquisition before the Block Land and Land Reforms Officer, such computerized text-data will be supplied by the Block Land and Land Reforms Officer after obtaining approval of the District Land and Land Reforms Officer or directly by the District Land and Land Reforms Officer on realisation of rupees one thousand per CD in respect of land records of each mouza. If, however, any non-Government Organization or any private Company or Firm or any other private Institution or Body Corporate applies for collection of bulk computerized text-data through any CD for the purpose of setting up industry or township or educational or research institution before the District Land and Land Reforms Officer, such computerized text-data will be supplied by the District Land and Land Reforms Officer after obtaining approval of the Director of Land Records and Surveys and Jt. Land Reforms Commissioner, West Bengal on realisation of rupees two thousand and five hundred per CD in respect of land records of each mouza.”
