

NOTIFICATION

Whereas, a large number of complaints have been received at this end relating to filling up of Water bodies/Wetlands which in turn is endangering the Bio-diversity in the vicinity.

Whereas, local level monitoring of such incidence of damage and destruction to wetland/water bodies is very much urgent.

The Governor is therefore pleased to constitute Block Level Water Bodies & Biodiversity Monitoring & Preservation Committee with the following members with immediate effect.

- 1 Block Development Officer-Chairman
- 2 Karmadhakshya, Fishery Standing Committee-Member
- 3 Karmadhakshya, Land Standing Committee Member
- 4 Karmadhakshya, Environment Standing Committee Member
- 5 Executive Officer/Extension Officer ofd the municipality Member
- 6 Block Land & Land Reforms Officer Member
- 7 Officer-in-Charge, Local Police Station Member
- 8 Fishery Extension Officer Member Convener
- 9 Local Environment activist as nominated by Regional Office of Pollution Control Board – Member.
- 10 Representative of West Bengal Pollution Control Board Member

In Municipal Corporation areas, Borough Level Committee will be formed with Borough Chairman as Chairman and Local Ward Councilors, Local Police Station-in-Charge, representative of West Bengal Pollution Control Board Regional Office, Local Land Department Officials, Fishery Department official as members of the Committee.

The Committee shall examine the status of Bio-diversity related to wetland / Water bodies of the area. All complaints of illegal filling up, steps to reinstate the water-bodies, if filled up and action against the offender with the ambit of existing relevant act / rules.

The committee shall met at least once in a month.
