With reference to your query in your above memo no, it is to be noted that if 'Pukur' and 'Pukurpar' are separate plot since RS operation and if the competent authority u/s 4C is satisfied that proposed conversion of 'pukurpar' will not cause any deleterious effect on the existing 'pukur', then conversion of 'pukurpar' may be allowed.

In this regard circular issued by Board of Revenue vide no.20232-585/361/78 dt. Kolkata, 27<sup>th</sup> December, 1978 may be consulted which clearly suggested for such cases to be classified as agricultural land; not as 'pukurpar'.
